

2022-2023 British Columbia Impact Report

The NIB Trust Fund is pleased to share that British Columbia (BC) was approved for \$2,078,922. Funding approved for organizations and individual recipients created enriching opportunities for First Nations people in BC. Over the past year, the NIB Trust Fund invested in 12 organizations in BC to operate programs that promote traditional culture and language learning, support youth development, provide employment and training opportunities, and offer healing programs across the province.

In addition, the NIB Trust Fund provided **163** individuals with the opportunity to pursue personal learning and educational goals. Award recipients are learning traditional languages and receiving culture, ceremony, and on-the-land teachings. Bursary and Scholarship recipients are pursuing post-secondary education degrees, certifications, and trade skills.






