

2022-2023 Manitoba Impact Report

The NIBTrust Fund is pleased to share that Manitoba (MB) was approved for \$1,314,890. Funding approved for organizations and individual recipients created enriching opportunities for First Nations people in MB. Over the past year, the NIBTrust Fund invested in 10 organizations in MB to operate programs that promote traditional culture and language learning, support youth development, provide employment and training opportunities, and offer healing programs across the province.

In addition, the NIB Trust Fund provided **201** individuals with the opportunity to pursue personal learning and educational goals. Award recipients are learning traditional languages and receiving culture, ceremony, and on-the-land teachings. Bursary and Scholarship recipients are pursuing post-secondary education degrees, certifications, and trade skills.




