These funds are made possible through survivor funds, from the Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement (IRSSA). We support First Nations individuals and communities through comprehensive funding to strengthen cultural revitalization, healing, and educational initiatives in the region.

Over the past year, we have partnered with 11 dedicated organizations. These organizations are working to create and deliver impactful programs that are preserving traditional knowledge, uplifting youth, creating meaningful employment opportunities, and supporting healing initiatives across the region. The work of these organizations contributes significantly to our communities and the well-being of First Nations in across Turtle Island.

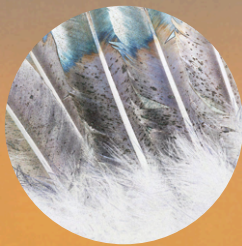
